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**Judul : Hubungan Pengetahuan Dan Sikap Perawat Dalam Melakukan Triase
Di Puskesmas Wilayah 2 Kabupaten Pandeglang**

ABSTRAK

Latar belakang: Salah satu pelayanan kesehatan yang diberikan yaitu pelayanan kegawatdaruratan medis. Kecepatan dalam penanganan pasien gawat darurat merupakan faktor penting yang dapat mempengaruhi prognosis dan keselamatan pasien. Dalam situasi gawat darurat, waktu adalah faktor krusial yang menentukan keberhasilan tindakan medis dan dapat mengurangi risiko komplikasi bahkan kematian. Triase merupakan tindakan yang dilakukan perawat dalam penanganan di instalasi gawatdarurat, pengetahuan dan sikap keterampilan tentang triase sangat berpengaruh terhadap penanganan di Instalasi gawatdarurat. Tujuan penelitian ini yaitu untuk mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan dengan sikap perawat dalam melakukan triase di Puskesmas wilayah 2 Kabupaten Pandeglang.

Metode: Penelitian ini menggunakan penelitian kuantitatif dengan desain *cross sectional*. Pengambilan sampel menggunakan total sampling, yaitu semua perawat yang ada di wilayah 2 sebanyak 75 orang. Variabel yang diteliti diantaranya usia, jenis kelamin, pendidikan, lama bekerja, pelatihan, pengetahuan triase dan sikap keterampilan dalam melakukan triase. Data dianalisis menggunakan analisis univariat dan bivariat.

Hasil: Hasil pada penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa sebagian besar responden usia 31 – 60 tahun (78%), jenis kelamin paling banyak perempuan (61,3%), pendidikan rata-rata responden yaitu D3 (61,3%), lama bekerja responden paling banyak lebih dari 10 tahun (40%), rata-rata responden telah pelatihan (88%) untuk pengetahuan triase masuk dalam kategori cukup (40%) dan sikap keterampilan dalam melakukan triase responden paling banyak masuk dalam kategori cukup (58,7).

Kesimpulan: Hasil dalam penelitian ini menunjukkan ada hubungan antara pengetahuan triase dengan sikap keterampilan dalam melakukan triase dengan *p-value* 0,001.

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Title : The Relationship Between Nurses' Knowledge and Attitudes in Performing Triage at Community Health Centers (Puskesmas) in Region 2, Pandeglang Regency

ABSTRACT

Background: One of the health services provided is emergency medical care. The speed in handling emergency patients is an important factor that can influence prognosis and patient safety. In emergency situations, time is a crucial factor that determines the success of medical interventions and can reduce the risk of complications or even death. Triage is an action carried out by nurses in the emergency department. Knowledge and attitudes related to triage significantly affect emergency care. The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between knowledge and attitudes of nurses in performing triage at community health centers in Region 2, Pandeglang Regency.

Methods: This study used a quantitative approach with a cross-sectional design. Sampling was conducted using total sampling, involving all nurses in Region 2, totaling 75 respondents. The variables studied included age, gender, education, years of service, training, triage knowledge, and attitudes in performing triage. Data were analyzed using univariate and bivariate analysis.

Results: The results of this study showed that most respondents were aged 31–60 years (78%), with the majority being female (61.3%). The average educational level of respondents was a diploma (D3) (61.3%). Most respondents had more than 10 years of working experience (40%), and the majority had attended training (88%). Triage knowledge was mostly categorized as adequate (40%), and attitudes in performing triage were also mostly categorized as adequate (58.7%).

Conclusion: The findings of this study indicate that there is a significant relationship between triage knowledge and attitudes in performing triage, with a p-value of 0.001.
