## FAKTOR – FAKTOR YANG BERHUBUNGAN DENGAN KEPATUHAN PEMERIKSAAN *TRIPLE ELIMINASI* DI PUSKESMAS BALEENDAH TAHUN 2024

### ABSTRAK

Tujuan Penelitian adalah untuk mengetahui dan menganalisis faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan kepatuhan pemeriksaan *Triple eliminasi* pada ibu hamil di Puskesmas Baleendah tahun 2024. Penelitian ini menggunakan rancangan penelitian kuantitatif dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Sampel sebanyak 60 orang dengan teknik *purposive sampling*. Pengambilan data dengan kuesioner. Analisis data menggunakan uji *Chi Square*. Hasil penelitian ini 61,7 % ibu hamil tidak patuh dalam pemeriksaan *Triple Eliminasi*. Tidak terdapat hubungan antara usia ( p-value 0,809), terdapat hubungan antara pendidikan ibu ( p-value 0,000 ), tidak terdapat hubungan pekerjaan ibu ( p-value 0,098), tidak terdapat hubungan pekerjaan suami ( p-value 0,257 ), terdapat hubungan dukungan suami/keluarga ( p-value 0,039 ), terdapat hubungan dukungan tenaga kesehatan ( p-value 0,042 ), terdapat hubungan pengetahuan ( p-value 0,000) dengan kepatuhan pemeriksaan *Triple Eliminasi*. Disimpulkan Tidak terdapat hubungan antara usia, pekerjaan ibu, pekerjaan suami dengan kepatuhan pemeriksaan triple eliminasi pada ibu hamil dan terdapat hubungan antara pendidikan, dukungan suami/keluarga, dukungan tenaga kesehatan, pengetahuan dengan kepatuhan pemeriksaan *triple eliminasi*. ### ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to determine and analyze factors related to compliance with *Triple Elimination* examinations in pregnant women at the Baleendah Health Center in 2024. This study used a quantitative research design with a cross-sectional approach. A sample of 60 people with a purposive sampling technique. Data collection using a questionnaire. Data analysis using the *Chi Square* test. The results of this study were 61.7% of pregnant women were not compliant with the *Triple Elimination* examination. There was no relationship between age (p-value 0.809), there was a relationship between maternal education (p-value 0.000), there was no relationship between maternal employment (p-value 0.098), there was no relationship between husband's employment (p-value 0.257), there was a relationship between husband/family support (p-value 0.039), there was a relationship between health worker support (p-value 0.042), there was a relationship between knowledge (p-value 0.000) and compliance with the *Triple Elimination* examination. It was concluded that there was no relationship between age, mother's occupation, husband's occupation with *triple elimination* examination compliance in pregnant women and there was a relationship between education, husband/family support, health worker support, knowledge with *triple elimination* examination compliance.
